- 2. Streamline financial management and ensure sound stewardship of School resources under the guidance of the Parish.
- 3. Minimize tuition increases to maintain affordability.
- 4. Set goals for and establish a financial reserve.

Sustainability & Campus Improvements

Goal: Provide a safe, secure, and welcoming environment and ensure the long-term viability of the School facilities and grounds in a manner that reflects a commitment to protecting the environment.

- 1. Establish comprehensive and staged plan for improvements and updates to facilities.
- 2. Continually asses and update security measures.
- 3. Obtain Maryland Green School certification.
- 4. Develop a plan to meet increased classroom and building space needs.
