

Saint Peter's Students Create Lenten Reflection Art

Students at Saint Peter's came up with the idea to mark the beginning of the Lenten Season, with a school-wide project combining art and faith. Each student decorated a tile with words, phrases or images related to Jesus or the crucifixion. Students were asked to reflect on the message that we are all part of the Body of Christ and therefore, we are all called to take up our cross and follow Jesus. Our crosses are joined with his. Student chose words including; sacrifice, love, forgiveness, devotion, peace, savior, faith, and follow me. The more than 300 tiles were then joined together to create an 8-foot-tall mosaic cross. Mrs. Helene Redmond, Saint Peter's Middle School Language Arts teacher and Mrs. Kelly Nichols, Saint Peter's second grade teacher, spearheaded the design and implementation of the project.
