- ✓ Please read Flat Stanley: His Original Adventure! by Jeff Brown.
- ✓ This year second graders will put a fun spin on our Flat Stanley summer reading project. Instead of creating a Flat Stanley, you will be designing a Flat Mr. Spadoni after our very own principal, Mr. Spadoni (See attached page).
- ✓ Mail your Flat Mr. Spadoni to a friend or relative near or far.
- ✓ Have your friend or family member take a photo or two with Flat Spadoni in any location that they choose. Make sure Flat Mr. Spadoni collects a few mementos from his trip. (Examples: flyers, shells, brochures, a newspaper article, tickets, etc.)
- ✓ Ask your family member or friend to mail Flat Mr. Spadoni, his pictures, and his mementos back to you.
- ✓ When he returns, you will create a small collage (no bigger than 12 inches x 18 inches) with the mementos Flat Mr. Spadoni found on vacation. You will use your collage to talk about Flat Stanley's summer adventures.
- ✓ Be sure to bring Flat Mr. Spadoni and your collage on the third day of school.



Note: During the first weeks of school we will introduce mapping skills by locating the destinations Flat Mr. Stanley visited while on vacation.
